Our Projects

- **Creating Canopies:** Planting 200,000 native trees & shrubs across Greater Sydney to reduce urban heat. Proudly funded by NSW Government.
- **Streamwatch:** Citizen science water monitoring program enabling community groups to monitor the quality and health of local waterways.
- **Southwest Sydney Koala Project:** Koala conservation efforts including planting & monitoring on private & public land, road safety, & wildlife carer support.

- **Cumberland Plain Restoration Program:** Conserving Cumberland Plain TECs through ecological/cultural fire, vegetation management & habitat restoration.
- **Youth Engagement:** Adventurous volunteering, networking & learning opportunities for 18 to 35 year olds across Greater Sydney.
- **Private Land Conservation:** Supporting private landowners to conserve natural areas on their properties and practice sustainable land management.
- **Wollondilly Catchment Restoration:** Delivering on-ground activities to restore the health & functioning of parts of the water catchment supplying Greater Sydney
